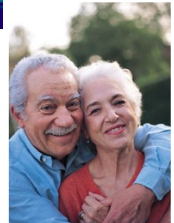

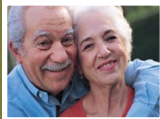

The Lipid Profile is a detailed measure of the fats in the blood. It measures the Total Cholesterol (TC); High Density Lipoprotein (HDL) "good cholesterol"; Low Density Lipoprotein (LDL) "bad cholesterol"; Triglycerides (TRG); and the TC/GHDL Ratio.

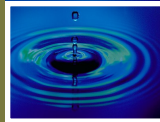
### Drug Testing

- Five- and Nine-Panel Urine Drug Testing

Urine testing, one of the most common screening methods, is an accurate and reliable way to detect casual drug use that occurred within the past 72 hours. The standard urine specimen five-drug panel includes: amphetamines/methamphetamine; cocaine; marijuana; opiates (codeine & morphine); and phencyclidine. Nine-panel includes the previous listed, plus barbiturates, benzodiazepines, methadone, and propoxyphene.

- Hair Testing

Hair testing for drugs of abuse is the only drug-testing method available that provides up to a 90-day drug use history. Five-panel includes: amphetamines; cocaine; opiates, PCP and THC.

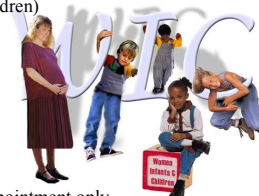

### HIV, STD, and Hepatitis Testing

- Confidential HIV Testing  
HIV Testing is available for a fee of \$10. Clients with positive results will be referred to HIV case management services.
- STD testing for Chlamydia, Gonorrhea and Syphilis  
Testing is available to clients for \$10. Clients must meet Department of Public Health's screening criteria. Patients will be referred to local medical facility for treatment. The office visit fee will be based on a sliding scale according to income and family size. For all criteria, call either office or visit our website.
- Free Hepatitis-C antibody testing  
This test is available to clients 18 years of age or older with a history of intravenous drug use.
